Speleo Projects Photo Archive

Speleo Projects is now accepting submissions of quality caving photographs for publication in its next annual Caving Calendar.

In addition, we have created an archive of photographs with mainly cave or karst topics. We are presently expanding the archive, and call on all cave photographers to submit their photos for selection. We shall duplicate those photographs we consider potentially viable for our printing programme. Original slides will be returned to the photographer (other procedures may be fixed individually, for instance safe-keeping of the original photographs by Speleo Projects). Should we at any time want to use a certain photo of our archive, we would ask the author for the original photograph and at the same time for authorization for publication thereof. The original photograph will remain with us until the publication is finished.

What we need are:

- 1) Digital photos, 8 megapixel or more.
- 2) Slides 24 x 36 mm or larger.

Original slides are better suited for printing. Of course, duplicates or low-resolution scans (.jpg format by e-mail) can be sent in for PRELIMINARY viewing as well. For quality purposes we ask for ORIGINAL slides for the final printing (we also accept professional-duplicates 4 x 5" or larger and high resolution scans of 60 MB min.). Each photographer is free in the choice of subjects of his cave-related slides.

Sending photographs:

The photographs must be packed carefully. Speleo Projects refuses any responsibility for loss or damage incurred during transport. For mail from overseas, airmail is strongly recommended. Photographs are highly valuable to the photographer. For this reason, sending via registered mail is in one's own best interest. Indicate on the green customs declaration: "Photographs for exhibition, to be returned to sender". **No excessive value indications please! This can cause substantial customs' fees for us.**

Return of photographs:

Slides which were not selected will be sent back to their photographers. All letters and parcels containing photographic material will be sent back by registered mail.

Reward:

The photographer will automatically receive reference copies of the publication in which his photo was published. In addition, an appropriate fee, in the range of our financial possibilities, will be paid. If requested, copies of the particular publication or other merchandise from our store can be received as an honorarium.
